

		This road was previously called Charnwood Road. Its function was to provide access to Henry Hall's property 'Charnwood' which was built in 1833.
		Most of its extent was subsumed by Kuringa Drive (from Kingsford Smith Drive to the Barton Highway) when construction of the division of Kaleen began. The remainder (being named with this instrument and as shown on the attached plan) was not renamed at the time but has become known as Kuringa Drive.
