Disallowable Instrument DI2009—153

made under the

Nature Conservation Act 1980, section 139 – Determination of fees

1. Name of instrument

This instrument is the Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 2).

2. Commencement

(1) Subject to section 2(2), this instrument commences on the day after notification.

(2) Part 3 of the schedule commences on 1 August 2009.

3. Revocation of previous determination

Disallowable instrument DI 2009-108 Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1) is revoked.

4. Determination of fees

The fee payable in respect of each matter listed in an item in column 3 of the schedule is the amount listed for that item in column 5.

5. Payment of fee

A fee listed in the schedule is payable to the Territory by the person requesting the goods or service listed.

6. Goods and services tax

Where applicable, GST inclusive fees are marked with a double asterisk (**).

7. Definition of non-exempt animal

For the purposes of this instrument, *non-exempt animal* means an animal that is not specified in a declaration under section 34(1)(b) of the Act.
