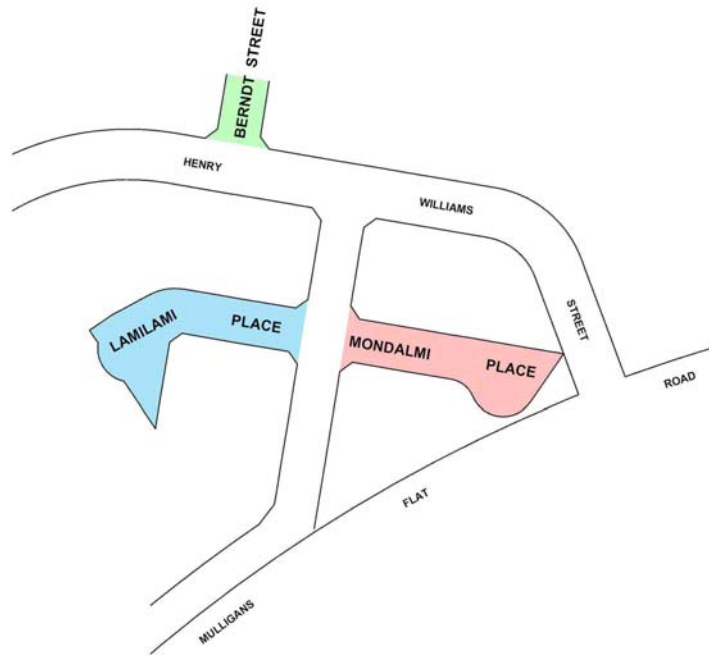

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Berndt Street	Catherine Helen Berndt AM (1918-1994) and Ronald Murray Berndt AM (1916-1990)	Eminent anthropologists - Ronald and Catherine Berndt had a considerable influence on the development of Australian anthropology and Aboriginal welfare.
Lamilami Place	Lazarus Lamilami MBE (c.1913-1977)	Indigenous leader, Methodist preacher and lecturer in Aboriginal studies. In 1968 he was appointed MBE 'for service to community'.
Mondalmi Place	Mondalmi (c.1910-1969)	Aboriginal matriarch and social commentator.
