

Road Transport (General) (Australian Road Rules - Nightlink Taxis) Exemption 2009 (No 1)

Disallowable Instrument DI2009—7

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, s13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (General) (Australian Road Rules – Nightlink Taxis) Exemption 2009 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Exemption

I exempt Nightlink taxis, operating under agreement with the Road Transport Authority (RTA), from the following Australian Road Rules (ARRs):

- ARR 132 (2) - to permit a driver to drive to the left of the dividing line; and
- ARR 208 (2) (a) - to permit the driver to position the vehicle to face in the opposite direction of travel of vehicles in a marked lane, subject to the conditions set out in clause 4.

4 Conditions

The exemption in clause 3 only applies if:

- (a) the operator of the vehicle has a current Nightlink agreement with the RTA;
- (b) the driver is rostered as a participating Nightlink taxi:
 - (i) between the hours of 12 midnight and 6am on Friday and Saturday nights; or
 - (ii) between the hours of 12 midnight and 6am on any other night in the case of a special event that has been approved by the RTA; and
- (c) the vehicle is operating in East Row, on the section of road between London Circuit and Alinga Street, Civic.
