

# Stock (Fees) Determination 2010 (No 1)

## Disallowable Instrument DI2010—117

made under the

*Stock Act 2005*, section 68 – Determination of fees

---

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Stock (Fees) Determination 2010 (No 1).

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2010.

### 3 Revocation of previous determination

The Stock (Fees) Determination 2009 (No 1) DI2009—84 is revoked.

### 4 Determination of fees

Subject to section 5 below, the fee payable in respect of each matter listed in an item in the schedule, column 3 is the amount listed for that item in column 5.

### 5 Calculation of basic maintenance fee

The basic maintenance fee payable for impounded stock is—

**A + B**

where:

**A** is, in respect of each animal described in an item in the schedule, part 4, column 3, the amount listed against that item in column 5; and

**B** is, in respect of each animal described in an item in the schedule, part 5, column 3, the amount listed against that item in column 5.

### 6 Payment of fees

- (1) A fee listed in the schedule, part 1 is payable to the Territory by the person requesting the goods or service listed.
- (2) A fee listed in the schedule, parts 2 or 3 and the basic maintenance fee is payable by the person seeking the release of impounded stock.
- (3) A fee referred to in 6(2) above is payable to—

- (a) the Territory, if the Territory has impounded the stock; or
- (b) the occupier of land, if that occupier has impounded the stock and the stock has not been subsequently impounded by the Territory.

**7 Goods and services tax**

Where applicable, GST inclusive fees are marked with a double asterisk (\*\*).
