#### Citation

**1.** This Statute may be cited as the *University of Canberra (Academic Board) Amendment Statute 2010.* 

#### Commencement

**2.** This Statute commences on the date of notification.

## Interpretation

**3.** In this Statute, unless the contrary intention appears:

"Principal Statute" means the Academic Board Statute 1990;

"Board" has the same meaning as in the Academic Board Statute 1990.

# Amendment of Section 4 of the Principal Statute

- 4. Subsection 4(2), 4(3) and 4(4)
  - 4.1 Omit the existing subsection 4(2).
  - 4.2 Omit the existing subsection 4(3).
  - 4.3 Omit the existing subsection 4(4) and substitute the following:
    - 4.4 The office of a member of the Board referred to in paragraph 3(1)(j) becomes vacant if the member:
    - (a) dies; or
    - (b) resigns from the Board; or
    - (c) the Council revokes the member's appointment.

The foregoing Statute is made by Council under section 40 of the *University of Canberra Act 1989* (ACT). The Statute was approved at Council meeting No. 130 on 6 November 2009.
