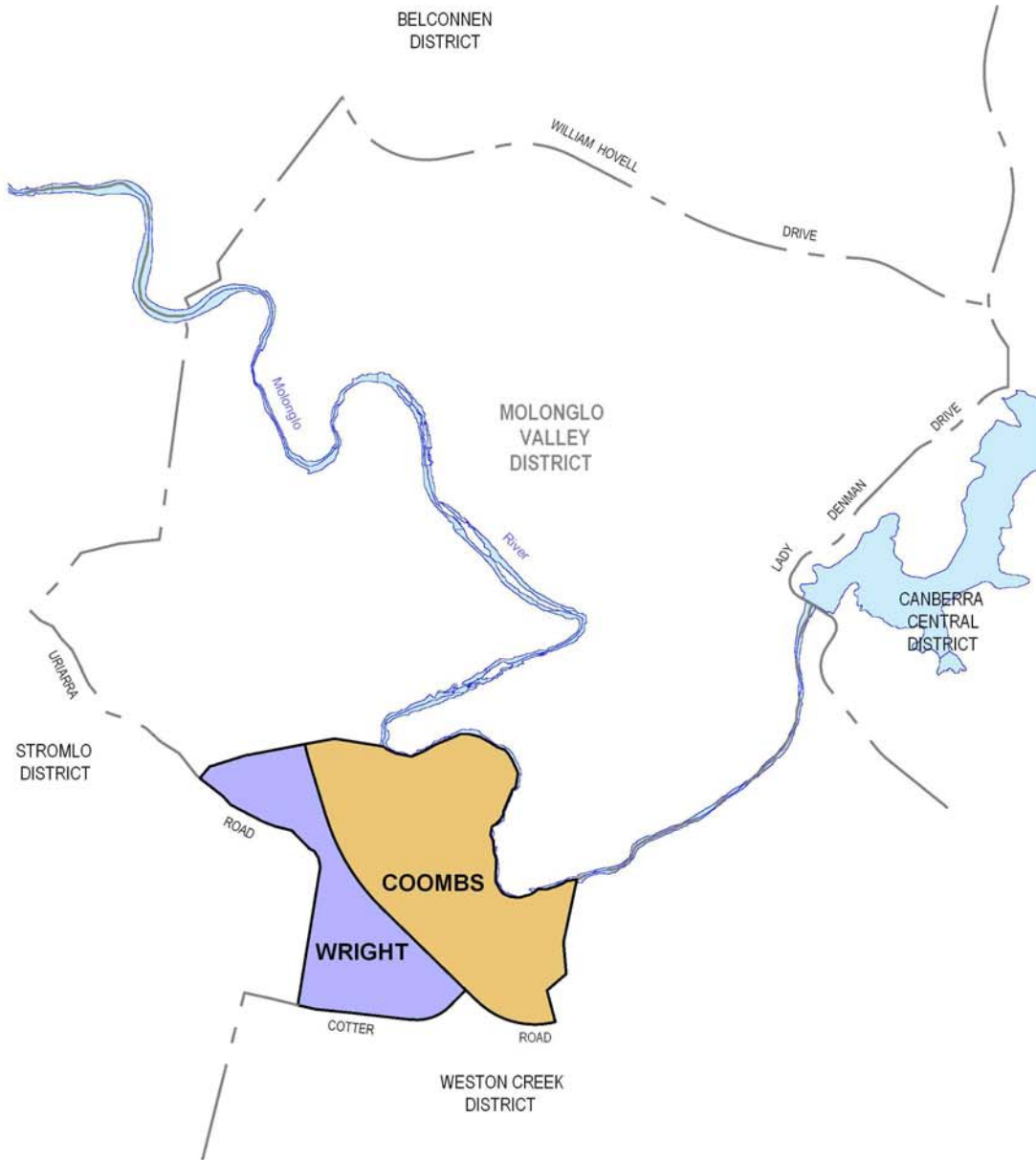

COOMBS	Herbert Cole 'Nugget' Coombs (1906-1997)	Dr Herbert Coombs was one of Australia's most outstanding and influential public servants, serving and advising seven prime ministers over a 30-year period. He had a profound influence behind the scenes in business and politics and worked hard to achieve a distinctive social, economic and cultural place for all Australians, particularly Aboriginal Australians.
WRIGHT	Judith Arundell Wright McKinney (1915-2000)	Ms Judith Wright was an Australian poet, critic and writer. She was a committed environmentalist and a lifelong fighter for Aboriginal rights and social justice. Judith was a major progressive figure in the life of 20 th century Australia.
