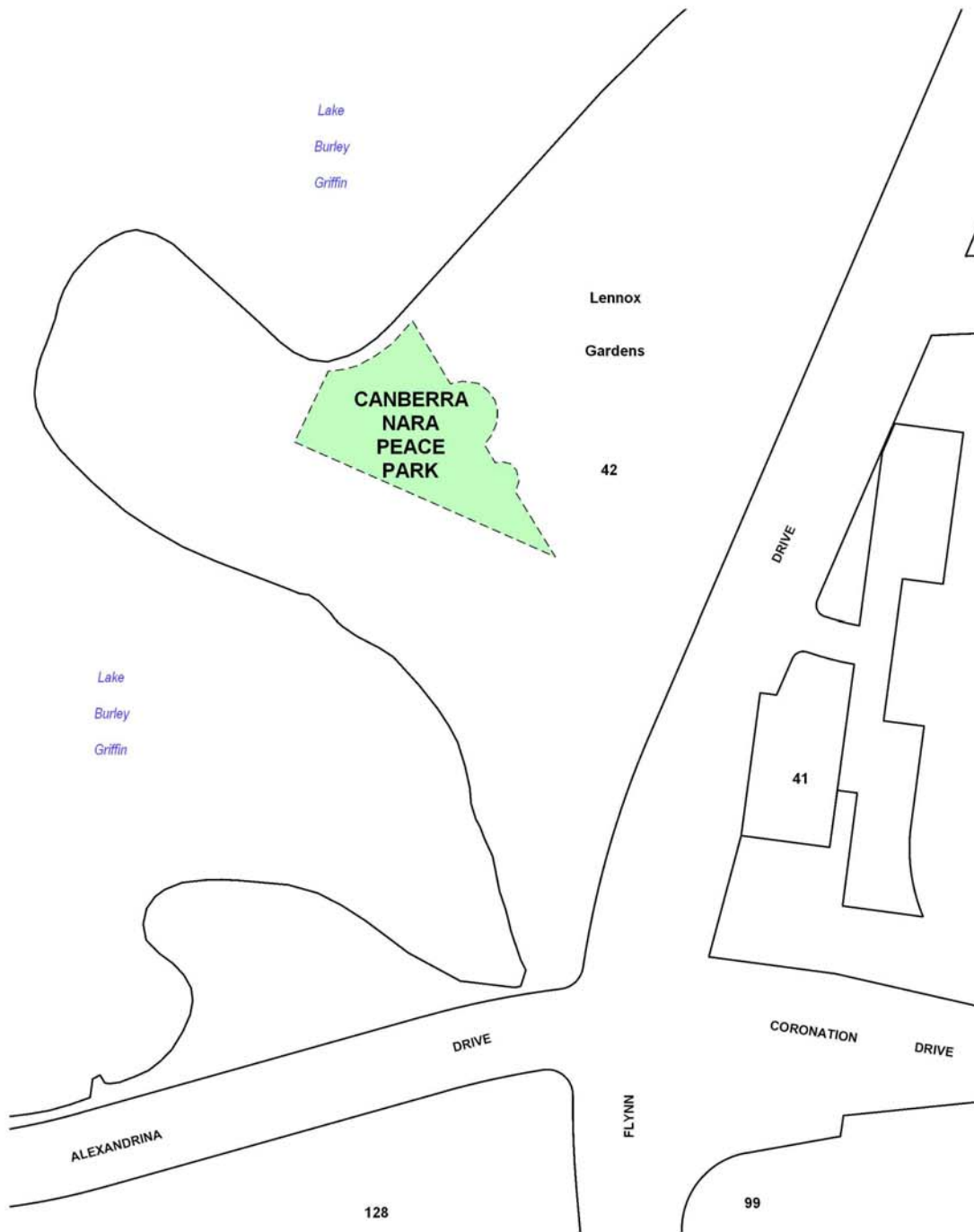

<b>NAME</b>	<b>SIGNIFICANCE</b>
<b>Canberra Nara Peace Park</b>	<p>This park is named in recognition of Canberra's sister city relationship with Nara, Japan. The name serves as a reminder of the great power that lies in the hands of ordinary men and women to achieve, through greater understanding between peoples and races, enduring peace between nations.</p> <p>The sister city relationship between Canberra and Nara is a symbol of friendship that encourages and assists groups in government, business, culture and community to make contact with each other and build relationships of mutual benefit and respect.</p>
