1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2010 (No 2)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 10 March 2010.

3 Declaration

I declare that the relevant provisions do not apply to the driver of a designated vehicle being driven for the purposes of attending and participating in the funeral service to be held for Tom Lunney at Norwood Park Crematorium on 10 March 2010.

4 Period of effect of declaration

The declaration under clause 3 has effect between 12.00 noon and 5.30pm on 10 March 2010.

5 Definitions

In this instrument:

designated vehicle means a vehicle with any of the following registration numbers:

- (a) YEZ 73V
- (b) YGR 19S
- (c) YER 68J
- (d) YGB 21U

registration number—see the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*, dictionary.

relevant provision means—

(a) the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999*, section 21 (3);
or

(b) the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2000*,
section 33 (7)
