

Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2010 (No 3)

Disallowable Instrument DI2010—34

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of Instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2010 (No 3)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification.

3 Definitions

In this instrument:

accredited hire car service operator—see *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, dictionary.

Note: A reference to an Act includes a reference to the statutory instruments made or in force under the Act, including any regulation (see *Legislation Act*, s 104)

designated vehicle means a vehicle (including a bus) driven for the purpose of transporting members of President Barack Obama's entourage in the ACT during his state visit to Australia in March 2010.

hire car—see *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, section 67.

4 Declarations—public passenger services

- (a) I declare that the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*, except part 8A (Additional public passenger vehicle insurance), does not apply to an accredited hire car service operator in relation to the operation by the operator of a designated vehicle as a hire car.
- (b) I declare that the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001* does not apply to the driver of, or a passenger in, a designated vehicle operated as a hire car by the operator of an accredited hire car service.

5 Declaration—vehicle registration

I declare that the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Act 1999* does not apply to a designated vehicle operated as a hire car by an accredited hire car service operator to the extent that the vehicle is not a hire car.

6 Declaration—public vehicle licence

I declare that the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999* does not apply to the driver of a designated vehicle operated by an accredited hire car service operator to the extent that the driver is required to hold a public vehicle licence.

7 Declaration—third-party insurance

I declare that the *Road Transport (Third-Party Insurance) Act 2008* does not apply to the driver or registered operator of a designated vehicle operated as a hire car by an accredited hire car service operator to the extent that the CTP premium paid for a CTP policy for the vehicle is not the premium for a hire car.

8 Declarations—period of effect

The declarations under this instrument have effect during the period beginning on the commencement of this instrument and ending on 25 March 2010.

9 Expiry

This instrument expires on 25 March 2010.
