

Public Place Names (Beard) Determination 2010 (No 1) Division of Beard: *Australian geological resources*

NAME	DESCRIPTION
Alumina Street	Aluminium oxide (Alumina) is a white granular material made from bauxite.
	Australia is a leading producer of alumina with 24 percent of global production. The Australian aluminium industry directly employs over 12 000 people.
Coal Court	Coal is a carbon-based fossil fuel.
	Coal is Australia's major mineral export and accounts for nearly 25% of Australia's export earnings. Australia is the world's 4th largest coal producer, producing almost 400 million tonnes of coal per year.
Copper Crescent	Copper is a metallic element.
	Australia is the western world's fourth largest copper producer producing more than 800 thousand tonnes of copper concentrates per year.
Nickel Street	Nickel is a metallic chemical element.
	Australia has substantial nickel resources and is one of the world's major nickel producers.
Tantalum Street	Tantalum is a heavy, hard grey metal.
	Australia is the world's largest producer of tantalum which is used in the production of electrical components.
Spongolite Street	Spongolite is a natural mineral product made almost entirely from fossilised sponges.
