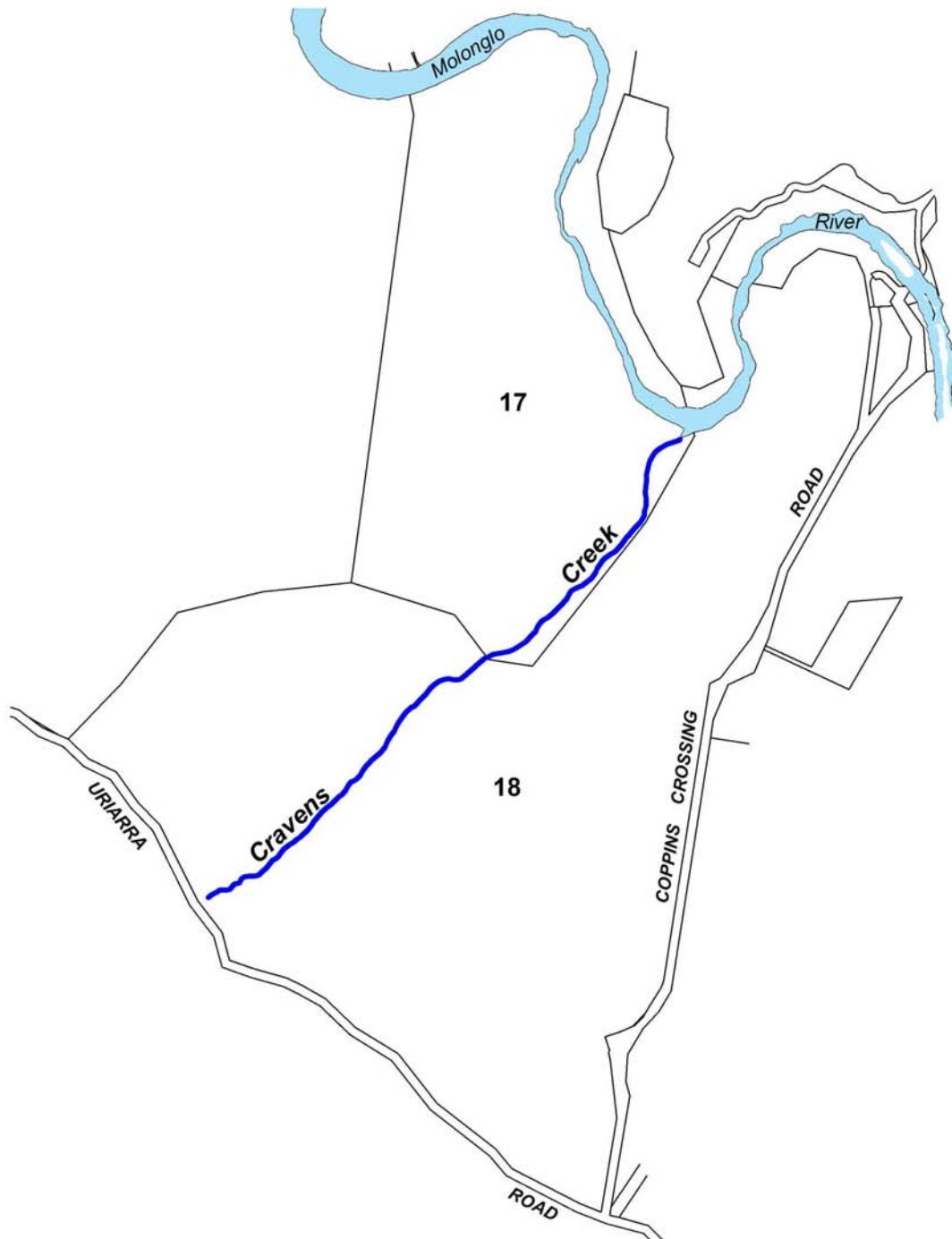

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Cravens Creek	Craven's Paddock	Historical local name The land known as <i>Craven's Paddock</i> was part of the 4,200 acre property on the Molonglo River held by Captain Edmund Harrison Cliffe during 1836-38. Captain Cliffe named the property <i>Craven Estate</i> . <i>Craven's Paddock</i> is within the area now identified as Blocks 17 and 18 Molonglo Valley District.
