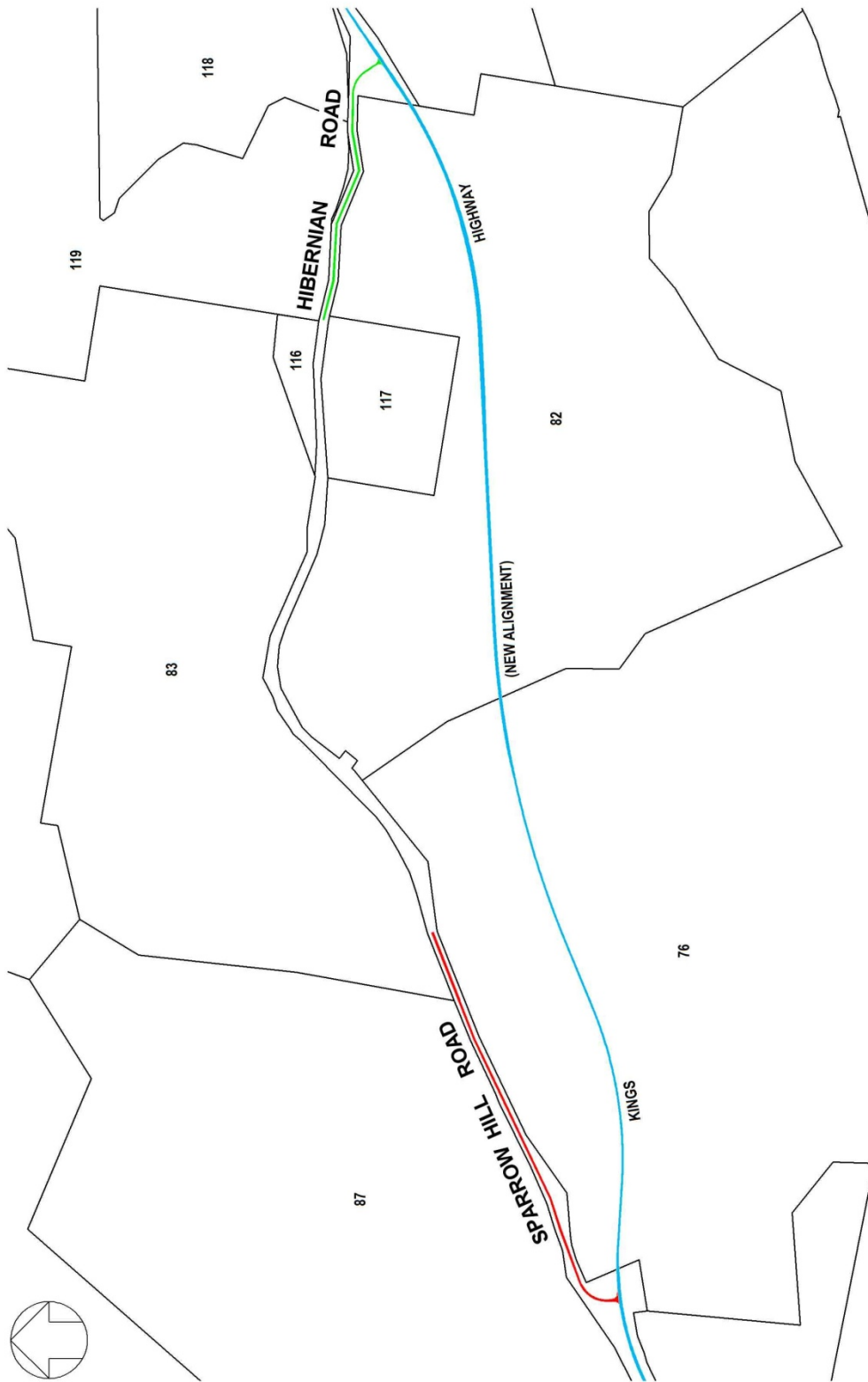

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Hibernian Road	Hibernian Hotel	The Hibernian Hotel was a mid 19 th century hotel, opened at about the time of the Kiandra gold rush, located on the coach road between Queanbeyan and Bungendore. George Sparrow was the proprietor. The hotel consisted of six rooms and was also the home of George Sparrow, his wife and his family of nine children. Parts of the foundations of the Hibernian Hotel were rediscovered in 2006.
Sparrow Hill Road	Sparrow Hill	Sparrow Hill is the name given to the hill located within the area of Kowen Forest approximately eleven kilometres east of Queanbeyan. The Sparrow Hill area is a popular location for recreation activities including archery, cycling and orienteering.
