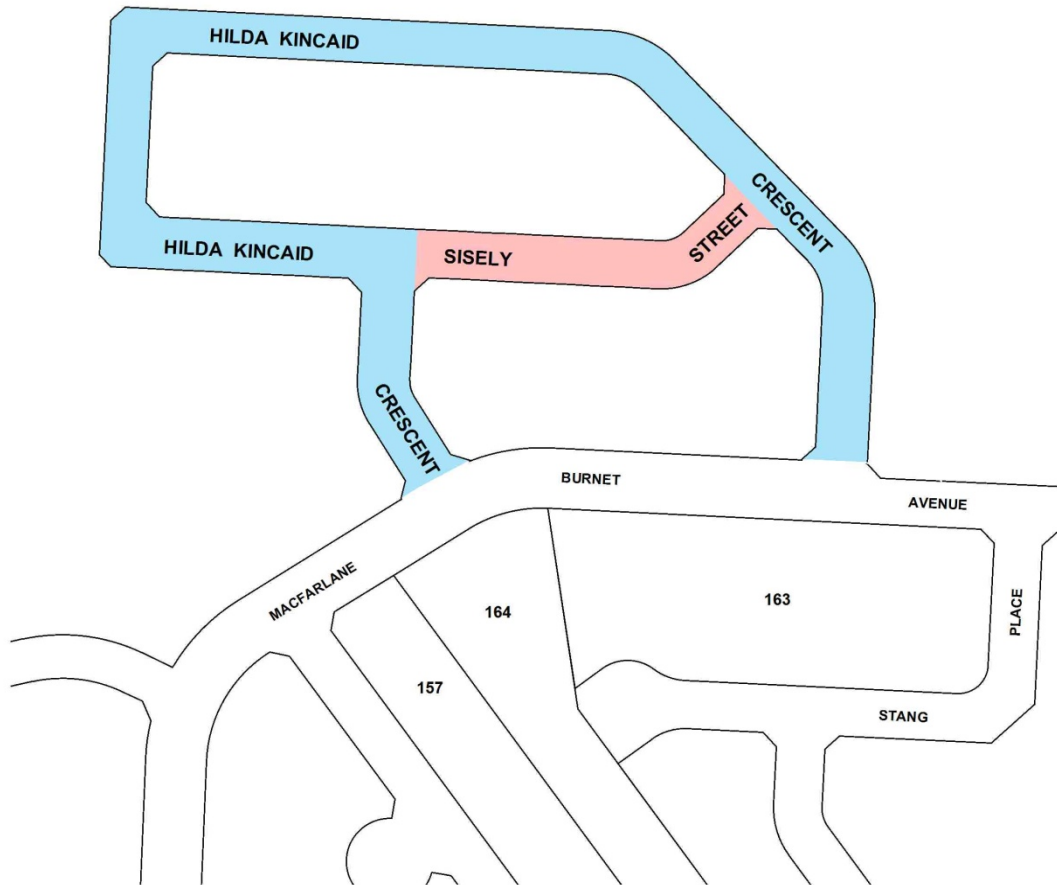

#### Division of Macgregor: *Medical Profession*

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
<b>Hilda Kincaid Crescent</b>	Dr Hilda Estelle Kincaid (1886-1967)	Medical practitioner  Medical officer (child welfare) for the Melbourne City Council from 1927 until retirement in 1952. Worked on a number of projects including the examination of the effects of environment and nutrition on the growth and development of underprivileged children. Her research was published in the proceedings of the Royal Society of Victoria and the <i>Medical Journal of Australia</i> . Committee member, Demonstration Nursery School which established the Lady Gowrie Child Centre in Melbourne in 1939.
<b>Sisely Street</b>	Dr Lorna Verdun Sisely OBE (1916-2004)	Surgeon  Founder and Consultant Surgeon, Monash Medical Centre Breast Clinic, 1979. First female surgeon to become a Fellow of the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons in June 1947. Awarded a 'Gordon Craig Fellowship' in Surgery in 1949 for post-graduate studies abroad; junior, then senior, Resident Medical Officer at St Vincent's Hospital, Melbourne, 1942-44; Honorary Assistant Surgeon, Children's Hospital, Melbourne, 1947-49; Surgeon and member of senior staff, Queen Victoria Medical Centre, 1947-81; member of the Anti-Cancer Council 1964-81.
