Planning and Development (Remission of Lease Variation Charges for Community Purpose—Health Services) Determination 2011 (No 1)

Planning and Development Act 2007, s 278B (When commissioner must remit lease variation charge—community purpose)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Planning and Development (Remission of Lease Variation Charges for Community Purpose—Health Services)* Determination 2011 (No 1).

- *Note* Terms used in this instrument have the same meaning that they have in the *Planning and Development Act 2007* (see Legislation Act, s 148). For example, the following terms are defined in the *Planning and Development Act 2007*, dict:
 - chargeable variation
 - gross floor area
 - lease variation charge
 - nominal rent lease.

2 Community purpose—Act, s 278B (2)

I, the Minister for the Environment and Sustainable Development, determine the provision of health services as a community purpose.

3 Remission of lease variation charges—certain health services variations—Act, s 278B (3)

- (1) This section applies to a chargeable variation of a nominal rent lease if—
 - (a) the only effect of the variation, and any other chargeable variation approved under the development application for the variation (other than a consolidation of the land under the lease with another lease), is to—
 - (i) authorise the use of the land under the lease for a health facility; or

- (ii) authorise the use of the land under the lease for a health facility and increase or limit the maximum gross floor area of a building permitted under the lease for use as a health facility; or
- (iii) increase the maximum gross floor area of a building permitted under the lease for use as a health facility; and
- (b) the lessee shows in writing that the operation of the health facility is fully or partly funded under the GP Development Fund.
- (2) I, the Treasurer, determine the amount of the lease variation charge for the chargeable variation to be remitted is an amount equal to 100% of the charge.
- (3) In this section:

GP Development Fund means the funding program established in the ACT Government's 2009/2010 budget and administered by the ACT Health Directorate for the development of the general practice workforce in the ACT.

health facility—see the territory plan (13 Definitions).

4 Remission of lease variation charges—other health services variations—Act, s 278B (3)

- (1) This section applies to a chargeable variation of a nominal rent lease that authorises development for the community purpose mentioned in section 2, other than a variation mentioned in section 3.
- (2) I, the Treasurer, determine the amount of the lease variation charge for the chargeable variation to be remitted is an amount equal to 0% of the charge.

5 Expiry

This instrument expires on 30 June 2013.
