1. Name of Instrument

This Instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2011 (No 1).

2. Commencement

This instrument commences on 31 January 2011.

3. Revocation of Previous Instrument

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument DI2010-99.

4. Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in the Schedule.

5. Payment of Fare

A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver.
