# Public Health (Fees) Determination 2012 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2012-235

made under the

Public Health Act 1997, s 137 (Determination of fees)

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**1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the *Public Health (Fees) Determination 2012 (No 2)*.

**2 Commencement**

This instrument commences on 1 November 2012.

**3 Determination of fees**

The fee payable in respect of each matter listed in column 2 of a schedule is the amount listed for that item in column 4.

**4 Payment of fees**

A fee listed in a schedule is payable to the Territory by the person identified in column 3 of a schedule.

**5 Refunding of fees**

Column 5 of the schedules specifies what amount, if any, of a fee identified in column 4 is non-refundable. A non-refundable amount is included to cover the costs associated with the processing and administration of an application.

**6 Revocation**

This instrument revokes DI2012-212 on commencement.
