NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Viidikas Street	Vicki Viidikas (1948-1998)	Poet and prose writer Vicki Viidikas was part of the Balmain group of modern poets, the “Generation of ‘68” as defined by John Tranter, and by the late 1960s and 1970s her work appeared in Nigel Roberts’ <i>Free Poetry</i> , Robert Adamson’s <i>New Poetry</i> , and Tom Shapcott’s anthology, <i>Australian Poetry Now</i> . Vicki’s collections of verse included <i>Condition Red</i> (1973), <i>Knabel</i> (1978) and <i>India Ink: A collection of prose poems written in India</i> (1984). A tribute to Vicki was held at the Sydney Writers Festival in May 2010 with the release of <i>Vicki Viidikas – New and Rediscovered</i> .
