

Attorney General (Fees) Amendment Determination 2012

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Attorney General (Fees) Amendment Determination 2012*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the commencement of the *Unit Titles (Management) Act 2011*.

3 Amendments

This instrument amends the *Attorney General (Fees) Determination 2011* (DI2011-115) by:

- a) inserting a new 2A “2A The fee payable for a service in schedule 2 for item 422 comes into effect on the commencement of the *Unit Titles (Management) Act 2011*.”
- b) inserting into clause 4(3) a new paragraph (c) “(c) the fee payable under the *Unit Titles (Management) Act 2011* for the matter stated in schedule 2, column 2 (item 422) is payable to the owners corporation.”
- c) amending schedule 1 to insert at the bottom of the table:
