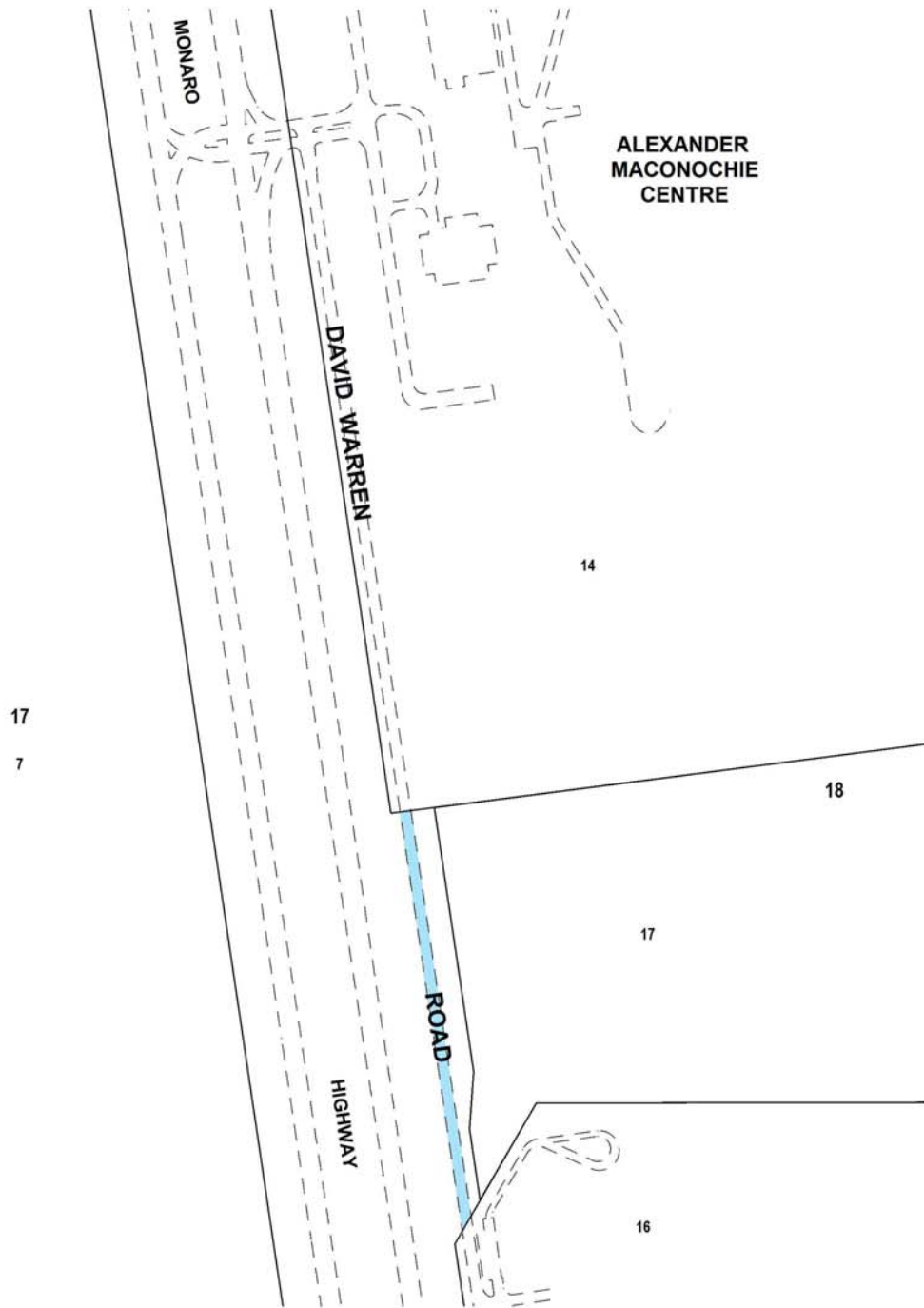

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
David Warren Road	Dr David Ronald Warren AO (1925-2010)	Aviation industry and science Australian inventor of the black box flight-data recorder. Served as Principal Research Scientist at the Aeronautical Research Laboratories in Melbourne from 1952 to 1983. He and his team designed and constructed the world's first flight-data recorder prototype in 1956; this device became known as the 'black box'. Served as chairman of the Combustion Institute (Australian & New Zealand Section) for 25 years (1958-83) and as Scientific Energy Adviser to the Victorian Parliament during 1981-82. Made an Officer in the General Division of the Order of Australia in 2002 for his services to the aviation industry.
