1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Civil Unions (Fees) Determination 2013.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2013.

3 Determination of fees

- (2) The fee for a matter stated in an item in the schedule, column 2 is payable by the person requesting the service.
