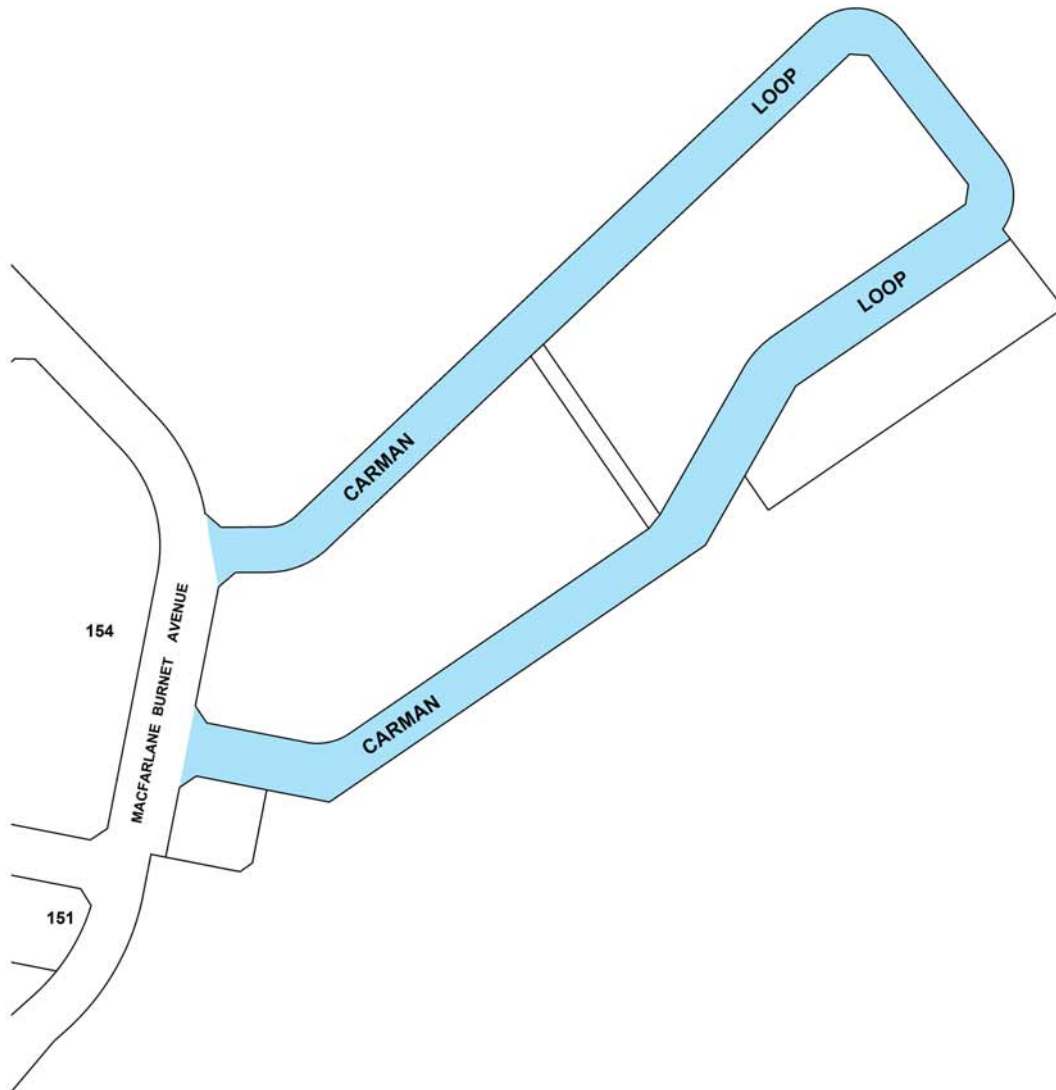

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Carman Loop	Dr Paul Gerard Carman (1950-2005)	Paediatrician Dr Paul Carman was widely respected for his contribution to children's health in Western Australia. He was appointed staff paediatrician at the Princess Margaret Hospital for Children in Perth in 1986 and Chairman of the Paediatric Clinical Care Unit in 1996. Dr Carman supported the care of children in rural areas through his work as a Registrar in the far north of Western Australia and as a visiting paediatrician and supporter of the Rural Paediatric Service. He ran regular remote paediatric clinics in the Pilbara region serving the local mining and Aboriginal communities. Dr Carman's legacy for paediatric hospitals in Perth was his vision to establish a Child Protection Unit to provide specialised medical and forensic services to children.
