

# Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2014 (No 1)

## Disallowable Instrument DI2014-2

made under the

*Nature Conservation Act 1980*, section 139 – Determination of fees

---

### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Nature Conservation (Fees) Determination 2014 (No 1).

### 2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

### 3 Determination of fees

The fee payable in respect of each matter listed in an item in schedule 1, column 3 is the amount listed for that item in column 5.

### 4 Payment of fee

A fee listed in schedule 1 is payable to the Territory by the person requesting the goods or service listed.

### 5 Goods and services tax

Where applicable, GST inclusive fees are marked with a double asterisk (\*\*).

### 6 Waiver of fees to enter Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve

- (a) No daily admission fee is applicable to the Tidbinbilla Nature Reserve on Australia Day (26 January 2014) and the Tidbinbilla Extravaganza (planned for April 2014).
- (b) No entry fee is payable by pedestrians or cyclists.

### 7 Dictionary

In this instrument:

***concession holder*** means—

- (a) a person who holds one of the following concession cards:
  - (i) a card issued by Centrelink or the Department of Veterans' Affairs commonly known as a "Pensioner Concession Card";
  - (ii) a Department of Veterans' Affairs Gold Card; or
- (b) a student who holds an appropriate student card identifying the person as a student attending:
  - (i) a school located in the Territory; or
  - (ii) a tertiary education institution located in the Territory.

***non-exempt animal*** means an animal that is not specified in a declaration under section 34(1)(b) of the Act.
