NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
<b>Barrer Hill</b>	Dr Peter Maling Barrer (1942-1997)	Ecologist, environmental consultant  Dr Peter Barrer made a significant contribution to conservation in the Lower Molonglo and broader region. He undertook the preliminary ecological mapping along the Molonglo River corridor, including the area of Misery Point, a habitat of the Pink-tailed Worm Lizard, <i>Aprasia parapulchella</i> . He was a strong advocate for establishing and maintaining conservation corridors, now known as 'connectivity conservation'. His meticulous approach to his work has left a legacy that continues to support ongoing conservation programs.
