

Holborow Avenue	Barbara Anne Holborow OAM	Judicial reform; children's advocate
	(1930-2012)	Magistrate, NSW Children's Court 1982-94, committed to achieving better judicial outcomes for children and young people; instrumental in setting up free legal aid for children in NSW, the first care court specifically for cases of neglect and a separate jail for first-time offenders aged 18 to 25 years. Barbara's philosophy was that "every child is everybody's responsibility". Known as the "kids' champion", her commitment to defend the rights of children and young people continued after her retirement from the bench. Awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia in 2002 and named NSW Senior Australian of the Year in 2012, Barbara wrote about her experiences in "Those Tracks on My Face" (1997), "Kids: Loving for Life" (1999) and "The Good, the Bad and the Inevitable" (2003).
