

Radiation Protection (Student) Exemption 2014 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2014–7

made under the

Radiation Protection Act 2006, 114 (Minister may exempt people, radiation sources etc)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Radiation Protection (Student) Exemption 2014 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

3 Exemption

The following persons are exempt upon the conditions prescribed in clause 4 of this instrument:

A student who is an undergraduate student undertaking course work or research in a university, or other educational institution, involved in the use of a regulated radiation source.

4 Condition

The student must be under immediate supervision at all times while using a regulated radiation source in any clinical situation and under general supervision at all other times.

Immediate supervision means supervision by a licensed person who is present at all times during and is observing and directing, the use of regulated radiation source by the person being supervised.

General supervision means supervision by a licensed person who oversees the person being supervised and ensures that the person follows safe radiation work practices in relation to the use of regulated radiation source.
