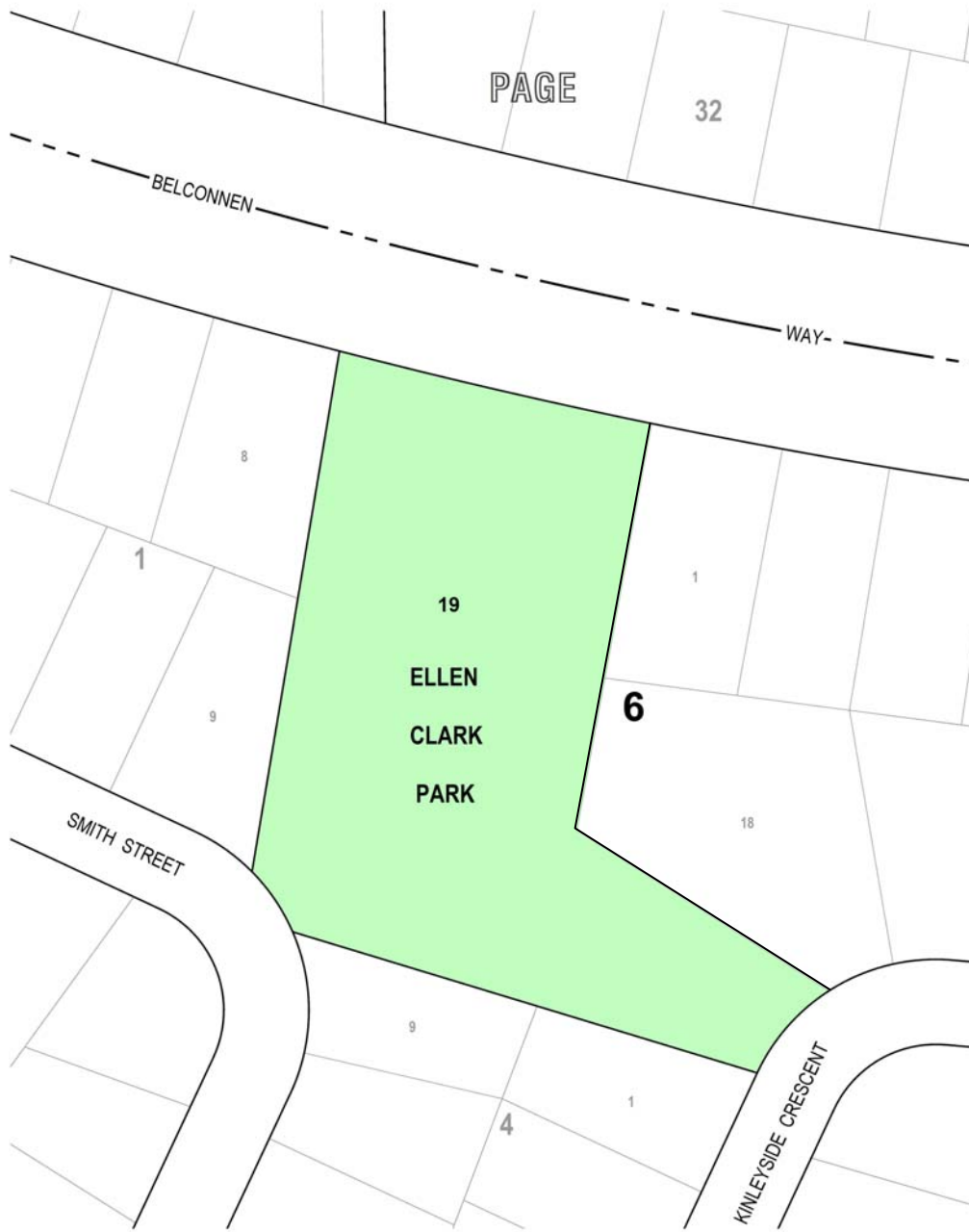

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Ellen Clark Park	Ellen Agnes Clark (1868-1956)	Teacher, ACT pioneer Mrs Ellen Clark was the longest serving teacher at the first Weetangera School. She was appointed to the school in July 1894 and remained until January 1920. Mrs Clark was later appointed to a teaching position at Sutherland, NSW and retired in 1926. The first Weetangera School had 27 students when it opened on this site in 1875.
