1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Emergencies (Fees) Determination 2015*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2015.

3 Determination of fees

- (1) The fee payable for a matter stated in an item in the schedule, column 2 is the fee stated in the schedule, column 3 for that matter.
- (2) Subject to (3), the fee for a matter stated in an item in the schedule, column 2 is payable by the person requesting the service.
- (3) The fee payable for items 279-288, and 290-292 is payable by an automatic fire alarm network provider.
- (4) For the purposes of the matters stated in schedule 2, column 2 (items 272 292), the following definitions apply:
 - "alarm system" means a fire indicator panel or group of fire indicator panels at the same location, which in the opinion of the Chief Officer ACT Fire & Rescue, is one system for the purposes of ACT Fire & Rescue attendance and false alarm management.

"false alarm" means an alarm from the alarm system of:

- (i) an automatic fire alarm network provider,
- (ii) where the alarm was caused by a malfunction or design flaw with the alarm system or any other action that led to the activation of the alarm which could have been reasonably prevented such that the attending ACT Fire & Rescue resource finds no fire connected with the alarm or finds that the fire connected with the alarm should not have activated the alarm, and
- (iii) within a period of not more than 60 calendar days, has been preceded by one or more false alarms from the same alarm system.

[&]quot;fire" means a fire, heat or ignition source however created and includes smoke.

- (5) A fee is not payable for a false alarm where, in the sole opinion of the Chief Officer, the alarm:
 - (i) could not have been prevented by reasonable maintenance of the alarm system: or
 - (ii) was activated by a circumstance beyond the reasonable control of the "owner", as defined in the *Emergencies Act 2004*.
- (6) A fee for items 272-292 is payable as a lump sum only, unless otherwise agreed by the Chief Officer ACT Fire & Rescue.

4 Payment of fees

The fee payable for a matter stated in an item in the schedule, column 2 is payable to the Territory.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes DI2014-122, the *Emergencies (Fees) Determination 2014*.
