Lotteries Act 1964, section 6 (1) (a) (ii) (Exempt lotteries)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Lotteries (Exempt Lotteries) Determination 2015 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Determination

I determine that the total value of prizes referred to under section 6 (1) (a) (ii) of the *Lotteries Act 1964* to be the value shown in Table A Column 2 in respect of the corresponding lottery product listed in Table A Column 1.

Table A	
Column 1	Column 2
Lottery Product	Total Value of Prizes
Trade Promotions	\$3,000
Raffles	\$2,500
Housie	\$1,000 per session*
Calcutta	\$1,000
Lucky Envelopes**	\$0
Other	\$1,000

* A session is a group of games run sequentially in close proximity (i.e. on the same day without a substantial break). **“Lucky Envelope” refers to the lottery raffles that are also known as “Bingo Tickets”, “Pull Tickets” or “Break Open Tickets” where letters, numbers or symbols are revealed by scratching or breaking open parts of the ticket in order to determine a winning combination.

4 Revocation

This instrument revokes *Lotteries (Exempt Lotteries) Determination 2011 (No 1)* DI2011-146.
