**1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the *Pest Plants and Animals (Pest Animals) Declaration 2016 (No 1)*.

**2 Commencement**

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

**3 Declaration of pest animals**

I declare the animals listed in the schedule to be pest animals in the Australian Capital Territory.

**4 Revocation of previous instrument**

The *Pests Plants and Animals (Pest Animals) Declaration 2005 (No 1)* (DI2005-255) is revoked.
