

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Taxi Fares for NSW Taxis in ACT Region Determination 2017

Disallowable Instrument DI2017–10

Made under the

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, section 60 (Power to determine maximum taxi fares)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Taxi Fares for NSW Taxis in ACT Region Determination 2017*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

3 Determination

I determine that the maximum fares for the hiring or use of a NSW taxi licensed under the *Passenger Transport Act 2014* (NSW) and operating subject to section 221P of the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Regulation 2002* are as follows:

- (a) until 30 April 2017—
 - (i) the amount chargeable for the hiring in accordance with the Fares Order for Taxi Services Determination of Maximum Fares for Taxis made under section 125 of the *Passenger Transport Act 2014* (NSW) on 25 November 2014; or
 - (ii) if that order is no longer in force or does not apply to the hiring—the amount chargeable for the hiring in accordance with the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*;
- (b) after 30 April 2017—the amount chargeable for the hiring in accordance with the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001*.

4 Disapplication of Legislation Act, s 47 (5)

The Legislation Act, s 47 (5) does not apply to this instrument.
