

Energy Efficiency (Cost of Living) Improvement (Priority Household Target) Determination 2017

Energy Efficiency (Cost of Living) Improvement Act 2012, s8 (Priority household target)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Energy Efficiency (Cost of Living) Improvement (Priority Household Target) Determination 2017*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Determination of Priority Household Target

I determine the priority household target for the total reduction in greenhouse gas emissions to be achieved by tier 1 National Energy Retail Law (NERL) retailers undertaking eligible activities at priority households for the compliance period 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018 (the **Compliance Period**) to be 20 per cent of the energy savings obligation of the relevant tier 1 NERL retailer for the Compliance Period.

Compliance Period – see section 12 of the *Energy Efficiency (Cost of Living) Improvement Act 2012* (the **Act**).

Energy savings obligation – see section 13 of the Act.

tier 1 NERL Retailer – see Dictionary in the Act.

Note 1 The only tier 1 NERL retailer in the ACT is ActewAGL.
