# Road Transport (General) Exclusion of Road Transport Legislation (Queen's Baton Relay) Declaration 2018 (No 1)

#### Disallowable instrument DI2018—4

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

#### 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (General) Exclusion of Road Transport Legislation (Queen's Baton Relay) Declaration 2018 (No 1).

# 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 25 January 2018.

# 3 Wearing of seatbelts by passengers 16 years old or older

Australian Road Rule 265 does not apply to a designated vehicle in the Queen's Baton Relay.

## 4 How persons must travel in or on a motor vehicle

Australian Road Rule 268 does not apply to a designated vehicle in the Queen's Baton Relay.

### 5 Conditions

When a person sits in a seat that is not inside the vehicle, the provided seatbelt must be worn. When a person is sitting in a seat that is not inside the vehicle, the vehicle is not to travel faster than 15km/h and is not to reverse.

#### 6 Definitions

In this instrument:

designated vehicle means the following vehicles:

(a) a vehicle used for filming the Queen's Baton Relay in the Australian Capital Territory.
