

Road Transport (General) Exclusion of Road Transport Legislation (Queen's Baton Relay) Declaration 2018 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2018—4

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Exclusion of Road Transport Legislation (Queen's Baton Relay) Declaration 2018 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 25 January 2018.

3 Wearing of seatbelts by passengers 16 years old or older

Australian Road Rule 265 does not apply to a designated vehicle in the Queen's Baton Relay.

4 How persons must travel in or on a motor vehicle

Australian Road Rule 268 does not apply to a designated vehicle in the Queen's Baton Relay.

5 Conditions

When a person sits in a seat that is not inside the vehicle, the provided seatbelt must be worn. When a person is sitting in a seat that is not inside the vehicle, the vehicle is not to travel faster than 15km/h and is not to reverse.

6 Definitions

In this instrument:

designated vehicle means the following vehicles:

- (a) a vehicle used for filming the Queen's Baton Relay in the Australian Capital Territory.

7 Expiry

This instrument expires on 27 January 2018.
