

Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation - Stopping in Permit Zone Declaration 2018*

Disallowable instrument DI2018—72

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, s 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation - Stopping in Permit Zone Declaration 2018*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 30 April 2018.

3 Declaration

I declare that section 185 (Stopping in permit zone) of the *Road Transport (Road Rules) Regulation 2017* does not apply to a driver of a declared vehicle identified in column 1 of the schedule stopped in a declared permit zone identified in the corresponding entry in column 2 of the schedule.

4 Revocation

The *Road Transport (General) Declaration that Australian Road Rule No 185 does not apply to drivers of certain vehicles 2000* (DI2000-359) is revoked.

A motor vehicle used by the Commonwealth Government of a Commonwealth Authority while displaying number plates commencing with the capital letter 'Z' with the capital letter 'Z' having a red colour.	Government Vehicles
A motor vehicle used by the Commonwealth Department of Defence while displaying number plates that identify the vehicle as being a vehicle used by the Department of Defence.	Government Vehicles
A motor vehicle used by the Australian Capital Territory Government or an Australian Capital Territory Authority while displaying number plates commencing with the numbers in the range of 200 to 299 with the numbers having a red colour.	Government Vehicles
A Police vehicle displaying the insignia or the markings of Australian Federal Police.	Government Vehicles
An emergency vehicle displaying the insignia or the markings of ACT Emergency Services.	Government Vehicles
A motor vehicle used by a foreign embassy or foreign mission while displaying blue background number plates either commencing with the capital letters 'DC' or 'DX'.	Diplomatic Vehicles
