1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Victims of Crime (Fees) Determination 2019 (No 1)*.

2 Revocation

This instrument revokes all previous Victims of Crime Regulation 2000 (Fees) determinations.

3 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2019.

4. Determination of fees

- (1) The fee payable for a service listed in the schedule, column 4 is the fee listed in the schedule, column 2 for that service.
- (2) The fee payable for a service listed in the schedule, column 2 is payable by the person requesting the service.

5 Payment of fees

The fee payable for a service listed in column 2 of the schedule is payable to service providers.
