

Utilities (Technical Regulation) Operating Certificate Fees Determination 2019

Disallowable instrument DI2019–204

made under the

Utilities (Technical Regulation) Act 2014, s 110 (Determination of fees)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Utilities (Technical Regulation) Operating Certificate Fees Determination 2019*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Determination of fees

I determine the fee payable for a matter listed in column 2 of schedules 1 and 2 to be the fee listed in the corresponding entry in column 3 of schedules 1 and 2 on the date the matter is invoiced.

4 Payment of fees

- (1) Fees in item 1 of column 3 of schedule 1 are payable to the ACT Government by the person applying for the operating certificate described in the corresponding entry in column 2.
- (2) Fees in items 2 and 3 of column 3 of schedule 1 are payable to the ACT Government by the unlicensed regulated utility holding the operating certificate.
- (3) Fees in items 1-3 of column 3 of schedule 2 are payable to the ACT Government by the person applying for the operating certificate described in the corresponding entry in column 2.
- (4) Fees in item 4 of column 3 of schedule 2 are payable to the ACT Government by the unlicensed regulated utility holding the operating certificate.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Utilities (Technical Regulation) Operating Certificate Fees Determination 2016* (DI2016-263).
