1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Workers Compensation (Fees) Determination 2019*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

3 Determination of fees

The fee payable for a matter stated in an item in column 2 of the schedule is the fee stated in column 4 of the schedule for that matter.

4 Payment of fees

The fee payable for a matter stated in an item in column 2 of the schedule is payable to the Territory by the person requesting the service.
