## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Victims of Crime (Fees) Determination 2021 (No 1)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2021.

## 3 Determination of fees

(1) The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is the fee listed in Schedule 1, column 4 for that service.

(2) The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is payable by the person requesting the service.

## 4 Payment of fees

The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is payable to the service provider.

## 5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Victims of Crime (Fees) Determination 2020 (No 1) DI2020-172*.
