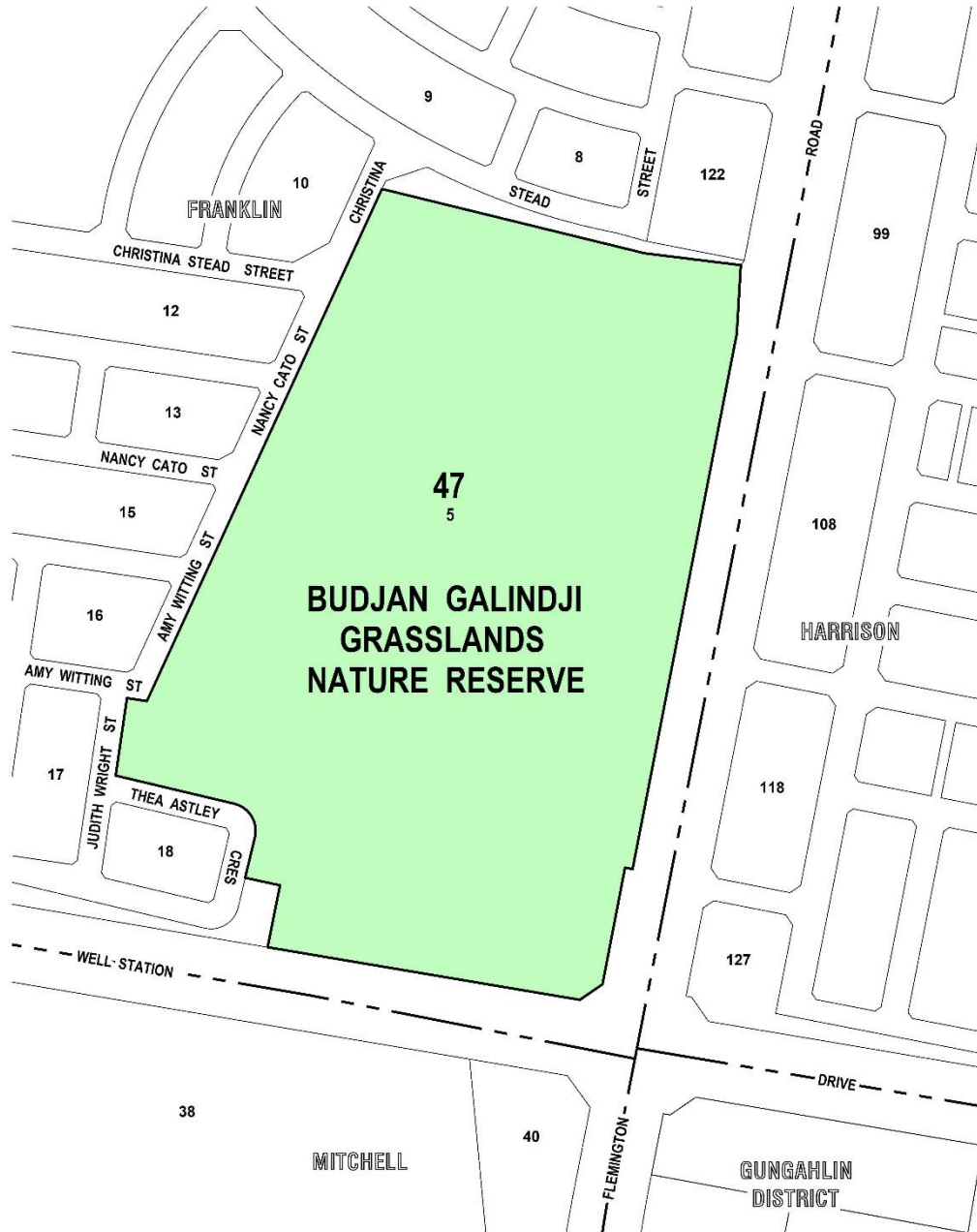

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Budjan Galindji Grasslands Nature Reserve	Budjan Galindji Ngunnawal vocabulary	In the Ngunnawal language, the words Budjan Galindji translate in English to ‘water bird’. The name recognises the migratory water bird, Latham’s Snipe, which visits the ephemeral wetlands within the reserve.
