1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Victims of Crime (Fees) Determination 2022 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2022.

3 Determination of fees

(1) The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is the fee listed in Schedule 1, column 4 for that service.

(2) The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is payable by the person requesting the service.

4 Payment of fees

The fee payable for a service listed in Schedule 1, column 2 is payable to the service provider.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Victims of Crime (Fees) Determination 2021 (No 1) DI2021-160*.
