1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Controlled Sports (Fees) Determination 2025 (No 1).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 July 2025.

3 Determination of fees

The fee payable in respect of each item in column 3 of Schedule 1 is the amount listed in column 4.

4 Payment of fees

A fee to which this determination applies is payable by applicants to Access Canberra at the time the application is made.

Fees relating to registrable event applications (Division 3.4, Table 2) are determined based on the information provided by the applicant. If the Controlled Sports Registrar or their representative determines that a higher fee is payable, an invoice will be issued for the balance. This fee must be made before the event commences, or if the event has commenced, no later than five (5) business days after the event.

Future applications will not be approved in instances where a fee balance is unpaid. This includes for a promoter, an organisation or another person representing the promoter.

5 Refund

Refunds may be granted in accordance with the Fee Refund Policy upon application by the applicant.

6 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Controlled Sports (Fees) Determination 2024 (No 1)* (DI2024–290).
