1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Professional Engineers (Fees) Determination 2025*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

3 Determination of fees

I determine the fee payable for a matter listed in column 3 of the schedule to be the fee listed in the corresponding entry in column 5.

4 Payment of fees

A fee mentioned in the schedule is payable to the Territory by the individual for the matter to which the application relates.

Note 2 The application fee for registration if the application is made under the principles of mutual recognition, under item 5 includes Australian jurisdictions and New Zealand. Australian jurisdictions are covered by the Mutual Recognition Act 1992 (Cth). New Zealand is covered by the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition arrangements

Formula for non-standard registration term

- (1) The fee payable for a registration issued for a period less than 3 years is the amount worked out in accordance with the following formula:

(F/36) x N where

F is the 3-year registration fee; and

N is the number of months, and part months, rounded up to the nearest number of whole months for which the registration is to be issued or renewed.

Example:

Elizabeth's registration is issued for a period of 2 years, 3 months and 2 weeks. For the formula **N** is 28. This is because there are 24 months in a 2-year period and the 3 months and 2 weeks is rounded up to 4 months, making a total of 28 months.

Note: An example is part of the instrument, is not exhaustive and may extend, but does not limit, the meaning of the provision in which it appears (see Legislation Act, s 126 (4) and s 132).
