1 Name of instrument

- (a) The fee payable for a matter stated in an item in column 2 of the schedule is payable to the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (*CMTEDD*) by an employer who applies to be a prescribed employer.
- (b) A fee paid under subsection (a) must be paid by CMTEDD to the DI fund.

5 Expiry
