Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Act 2001, section 60 (Power to determine taxi fares)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2025 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 20 June 2025.

3 Determination

I determine that the maximum fares relating to the hiring or use of a taxi are as specified in column 3 of schedule 1 to this instrument.

4 Payment of fare

A fare to which this determination applies is payable by a customer for using taxi services and is payable to the taxi driver with the exception of the lift fee, which is payable by the ACT Government to the taxi driver.

5 Revocation

This instrument revokes the *Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Maximum Fares for Taxi Services Determination 2024 (No 1)* DI2024-199.
