

Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation (Polar Plunge Canberra) Declaration 2026 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2026–187

made under the

Road Transport (General) Act 1999, s 12 (Power to include or exclude areas in road transport legislation)

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) Application of Road Transport Legislation (Polar Plunge Canberra) Declaration 2026 (No 1)*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 16 August 2026.

3 Declaration

I declare that for the period set out in section 4, the ***disapplied legislation*** does not apply to the area identified in Schedule 1.

4 Period of effect of declaration

The declaration has effect if the ***event*** proceeds at the Civic Pool on 16 August 2026, for the period beginning 9:30am to 4:00pm that day.

5 Definitions

disapplied legislation means the following provisions of the *Road Transport (Road Rules) Regulation 2017*:

- (a) Section 205 (Parking for longer than indicated);
- (b) Section 205A (Parking outside time indicated);
- (c) Section 207 (Parking where fee payable);
- (d) Section 213C (Metered parking – parking fee);
- (e) Section 213D (Metered parking – maximum length of stay);
- (f) Section 213K (Ticket parking – display of ticket); and
- (g) Section 213M (Ticket parking – maximum length of stay).

event means the Polar Plunge Canberra 2026 for Special Olympics Australia.
