DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT NO. 105 OF 1996

Section 132 of the *Casino Control Act 1988* (the Act) allows the Minister to determine fees that relate to the purposes of the Act.


The Act states that an application for a casino employee's licence, as well as a variation, renewal and replacement of a licence are subject to the applicant paying the Casino Surveillance Authority a determined fee.

I have determined that the fee structure from 1 July 1996 regarding casino employee's licences shall be:

| Renewal of an Employee's Licence (section 97) | \$ 44.00 |

| Replacement copy of an Employee's Licence (section 99) | \$ 33 00 |

All fees are based on the cost of recovery of the Casino Surveillance Authority's administration time and the fees charged by external organisations for security and credit checks. The proposed fees are consistent with those charged in other States.
