REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 110 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Pursuant to section 110 of the Animal Welfare Act 1992 ('the Act'), the Minister may, by notice published in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes the existing Determination and sets out the fees for the licence to use or breed an animal for the purpose of research or teaching and the fee for a circus permit.

The Act protects the welfare of animals in the ACT. Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The licences and fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees:

- (a) the fee payable for the purposes of section 26 of the Act for pretertiary schools for a licence to use or breed an animal for the purposes of research or teaching is NIL (NIL);
- (b) the fee payable for the purposes of section 26 of the Act for all other applicants for a licence to use or breed an animal for the purposes of research or teaching is \$540 (\$525); and
- (c) the fee payable for the purposes of section 53 of the Act for a circus permit is \$50 (\$48).
