REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 113 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Pounds Act 1928 ('the Act') regulates the impounding of cattle, horses, sheep, pigs, mules and goats.

Under section 7 of the Act the Minister may determine fees and charges for the purposes of the Act. This Determination revokes the existing Determination and sets pound fees, driving charges, deterrent fees, trespass rates, sustenance fees, and inspection of books fees under the Act. The fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and generally increased in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous charges.
