REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 180 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Water Pollution Act 1984 ('the Act') controls the pollution of the waters in the Australian Capital Territory. Under section 39 of the Act the Minister may determine fees

This determination revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets fees for the grant of licences under the Act. Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The licences and fees payable for the purposes of section 19 of the Act are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees

Storm water run-off laden with silt, soil, earth, mud, stones, clay, colloids, organic matter or other like material, being run-off caused by the disturbance of the land surface during the process of land development

Where the area of the premises specified in the application is

- (1) less than 1Ha -355 00 (345 00)
- (2) 1Ha or more but less than 2Ha 570 00 (555 00)
- (3) 2Ha or more but less than 5Ha 920 00 (895 00)
 - (4) 5Ha or more but less than 20Ha -1 520 00 (1,475 00)
 - (5) 20Ha or more 2 320 00 (2,255 00)

All other discharged waste to be discharged in one day is

When the maximum quantity of waste

- (1) less than 100 kilolitres 985 00 (955 00)
- (2) 100 kilolitres or more but less than 1 megalitre 1,135 00 (1,100.00)

- (3) 1 megalitre or more but less than 10 megalitres 1,320.00 (1,280.00)
- (4) 10 megalitres or more but less than 50 megalitres 4,045.00 (3,925.00)
- (5) 50 megalitres or more 5,485.00 (5,325 00)

Where the discharge of waste is likely to take place on less than three consecutive days and not more than two events in a licence year

- (1) less than 100 kilolitres per day - 240 00 (230 00)
- (2) 100 kilolitres per day or more but less than 1 megalitre per day -275 00 (265 00)
- (3) 1 megalitre per day or more but less than 10 megalitres per day -320 00 (310 00)
- (4) 10 megalitres per day or more but less than 50 megalitres per day -590 00 (575 00)
- (5) 50 megalitres per day or more- 800 00 (775 00)
